ROAD DEPARTMENT-Continued

The department has replaced two Cross Drain Culverts near Hall Simpson Road. Repaired a ditch in a Cul-de-sac on Lexington Court in **Corman's Crossing** in District #4. A large section on the ditch line on Hugh Ice Loop had to be repaired due to recent flooding. Graded a ditch in a Cul-de-sac in Creek Chase subdivision in District #5. Baskets were installed on Eggen Lane to keep the shoulders from washing out. The department is working on a replacing an existing clay pipe that had collapse on Petersburg Road. Trimming weeds and spraying around bridges on Higdon Loop in District #1, and working on Pottershop and the Woodlawn Road areas in District #2. Mowing Crews are in District #5. The department is down to one tractor due to an accident. The Boom Mower is currently in District #3.
