AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING AS AMENDED ZONING MAP ENTITLED "ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY"

BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED IN NELSON COUNTY AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED FROM A-1, AGRICULTURE DISTRICT TO BE REZONED AS B-4, GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County, Kentucky, on August 13, 2013 held a public hearing under the provisions of KRS Chapter 100, and after careful consideration, the Commission on August 27, 2013, tied 4-4 and made no recommendation to the Fiscal Court of Nelson County;

WHEREAS, the Nelson Fiscal Court held a first reading on September 17, 2013 and made the factual determination that there have been major changes of an economic, physical or social nature within the area involved which were not anticipated in the adopted comprehensive plan and which have substantially altered the basic character of the area;

WHEREAS, the Nelson Fiscal Court approved for rezoning on the condition that the zoning of the property revert back to A-1 zoning if Jeffrey and Wendy Lewis cease operation of

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their tool and die business at this location or sell the business to a non-immediate family member; and

WHEREAS, after due advertisement held a second reading and adoption on October 1, 2013, and after due consideration,

NOW, THEREFORE, UPON MOTION OF Jerry Hahn,

SECONDED BY Bernard Ice, AND A VOTE BEING HAD

AND THE COUNTY JUDGE ANNOUNCING THAT THE MOTION CARRIED,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF NELSON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION I: Boundaries of the district as shown on district map entitled "ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY" be and the same are hereby amended for reasons adopted and stated in the recommendation of the Nelson Fiscal Court, specifically including the special condition, based upon the sworn testimony of the agent of the applicant, that the zoning will revert to A-1 (Agricultural District) in the event that the applicants cease operation of their tool and die business or sell the business to a non-immediate family member, all of which is made a part hereof as if fully set out herein, so that the following described property of Jeffrey and Wendy Lewis is presently A-1, Agriculture District be and the same is placed as B-4, General Business District and said property is described as follows:

Beginning at an existing iron pin in the south line of KY 48 corner to Tract 2 of Jeffrey and Wendy Lewis (Plat Cbt. 10 – Slot 2); thence, with the south line of the road, 50' from and parallel to the centerline, S 82 degrees 41'15"E - 55.77' to an iron pin set; thence, with a division line of Lewis, S 33 degrees 36'46"W - 454.26' to an iron pin set in the line of Tract 1 of Jeffrey and Wendy Lewis (Plat Cbt. 10 – Slot 2); thence, with the lines of Tract 1, S 53 degrees 12'18"E - 168.07' to a post, S 12 degrees 19'22" W - 211.75' to a post and S 85 degrees 24'07"W - 282.51' to a post; thence, with division lines of Tract 1, N 05 degrees 39'59"E - 155.16' to an iron pin set and N 33 degrees 36'46"E - 247.09' to an existing iron pin corner to Tract 2; thence, with Tract 2, N 33 degrees 36'46" E - 426.77' to the point of beginning containing 2.319 acres.

Shain is presently A-1, Agriculture District be and the same is placed as R-1A, Single Family Residential District and said property is described as follows:

SURPLUS VEHICLES - Joe Prewitt recommended that two EMS vehicles be declared as surplus and sold. During discussion, suggestions were made that various other items also be included. On motion of Bernard Ice, second of Jerry Hahn, by unanimous vote of the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that two EMS vehicles (1995 Ford Crown Vic--VIN 2FALP71W4SX183255 - 141,073 mi. and 1997 Ford E-350-- VIN 1FDJS34F8VHB56113 - 303,684 mi.), 1994 Caterpillar IT18F loader and any attachments, and an old street sweeper be declared as surplus and bid for sale, with Judge Watts authorized to set a minimum bid on items based on scrap metal price.

UPDATE ON EMS SERVICES PROVIDED - Joe Prewitt reported that 1) EMS had provided extra coverage for the Iron Horse Festival and the Bourbon Festival; 2) had provided a Mobile Command Unit at the Bourbon Festival, this in conjunction with various other emergency agencies; 3) provided coverage during the statewide band concert held recently at Nelson County High; 4) conducted an Awareness Outreach Program at New Haven Elementary. Several EMS members attended the KY Board of EMS and the KY Ambulance Providers Association conference meetings, during which conference Joe Prewitt was appointed as Vice-Chair for both of these groups. He was also appointed to the Legislative Committee with KAPA and to the Executive Committee with KY Board of EMS.

GRANTS - Prewitt reported that all documentation has been submitted for reimbursement on the generator Hazard Mitigation grant and on the Justice Assistance Grant for the touchscreen control panel for the jail. Reimbursements should be forthcoming.

**ROAD DEPARTMENT

BULL RUN - County Engineer Jim Lemieux told Court members that guardrail is complete on the Bull Run project, barricades are down, and road technically is open, although the contractor has finishing jobs yet to do--- seeding, strawing, and signage.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE - Lemieux reported 1) that bushhogging is on-going in Dist. 1; 2) that hot-mix patching has been completed, although costs have exceeded amount budgeted (method of budgeting will be evaluated in order to address the overrun); 3) that chip-sealling will begin on certain sections of various roads throughout the county; and 4) that Mago is doing paving now, having completed Greer Ln. yesterday. He also told Court members that Bluegrass Cellular has requested encroachment permits off several roads throughout the county. Court members want to look at advisability of this action (request is for installation of fiberoptic cable).

BURG BRIDGE - Discussion was held concerning boards on the old Fredericksburg Bridge that are deteriorating due to weather; however, Jim Lemieux told Court members that some of the metal structure beneath the floor of the bridge is also in disrepair. Judge Watts and Judge Settle of Washington County will confer as to what should be done if the bridge is to be maintained.

**LANDFILL/SOLID WASTE

ROADSIDE PICKUP - Roadside pickup project for this season will be done from Oct. 12 through Nov. 1, following fall break.

LANDFILL SHOP - Brad Spalding asked Court members to look at drawings of proposed maintenance shop at the landfill and to get back as soon as possible with any suggestions. As requested by Spalding, on motion of Bernard Ice, second of Jerry Hahn, by unanimous vote of the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to authorize Brad Spalding to move forward with bids for everything that is needed for the shop construction. He will complete specs and bring them back to the Court in the near future. Location for this shop will be on a site on the Mattingly property across the road from the landfill.
