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ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SETTING OF PROPERTY TAX RATES TO FUND THE 2021-2022 BUDGET OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON

WHEREAS the County adopted a budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year on June 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS property tax rates to fund the said budget could not be adopted prior to the County's receipt of the State Local Finance Officer's Certification of the Maximum Permissible Revenue from ad valorem taxes in accordance with KRS 68.245, which was received July 21, 2021; and

WHEREAS the said certification establishes compensating and maximum tax rates for the County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: There is levied for the year 2021 the ad valorem tax rates per \$100.00 assessed valuation on all taxable property with the County for General Fund as indicated:

SECTION TWO: The said revenues shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of the budget adopted by the Fiscal Court of the County of Nelson on June 15, 2021.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be published in The Kentucky Standard newspaper by title and summary within 30 days after adoption.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication.
