Dear County Judge-Executive:

In accordance with the provisions of KRS 64.5275, the Department for Local Government has calculated the annual compensation which shall be paid to County Judge-Executives, County Clerks, Sheriffs and Jailers for the 2022 calendar year.

The compensation for the above named officers is determined by a salary schedule containing nine levels corresponding to nine population groups and four salary steps for each population group. After a cost of living adjustment for 2022, the maximum salary for any official for calendar year 2022 is \$140,364.37; the minimum is \$77,200.40.

The actual salary for any individual officer named above depends on (1) the population of the county in which he/she serve and (2) the number of years of experience, as certified to DLG. This information has been compiled on the attached schedule entitled: "Maximum Salary Authorizations - 2022: County Judge Executives" to display the 2022 authorized salary for the office of County Judge-Executive in each of Kentucky's counties.

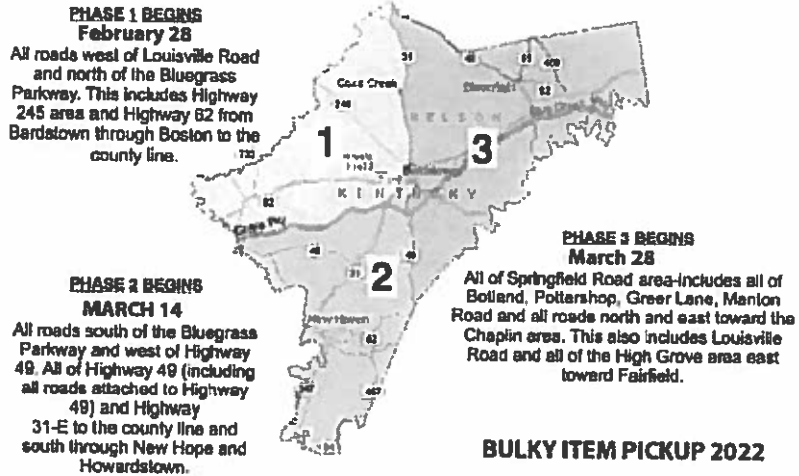
